Bespoke finishing interior and architectural commissions including the installation of ceilings and block wall partitions, marble flooring, and fixtures including kitchen cabinets, bathtubs, walk-in wardrobes are also progressing closely behind the structural works. Maintaining its progressive work, the estimated topping-off time for the 62 floors will be by done by Q1 2021.
