# ArtMoments Debuts in Bali with Aim to Establish Bali as One of the Art Destinations in Southeast Asia



ArtMoments Bali 2023 is the first large scale art fair to be held in Bali.

**Bali, June 2023** — The inaugural ArtMoments Bali 2023 has officially opened its doors today, 23 June 2023. The three-day art fair is being held at InterContinental Bali Resort in Jimbaran from 23 - 25 June 2023. ArtMoments Bali is embracing the theme of "Infinite Boundaries" featuring more than 100 artists from 15 galleries from Indonesia and beyond, and 2 special presentations.

ArtMoments Bali (AMB) is Indonesia's only hotel art fair and aspires to provide an intimate environment where art collectors can discover art, connect with galleries, and grow their collections. The art fair aims to support galleries with an Indonesian focus and an international scope presenting emerging and established artists. The Bali edition of the fair will support ArtMoments' mission to facilitate meaningful engagement between industry professionals, collectors, and institutions and channel this through an exciting public program that intends to disseminate these perspectives to a larger audience. The art fair will debut on 23 June for VIP and



invitation-only guests from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m. Later, on 24 and 25 June 2023, all art lovers and the public are welcome to visit ArtMoments Bali, free of charge, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Under the artistic direction of Rizki Zaelani, ArtMoments Bali will embrace the theme of "Infinite Boundaries." This theme highlights the ever-evolving nature of contemporary fine art, reflecting the present era's changing lives and societal dynamics. Artists participating in the event will embrace the challenge of creating artworks that mirror the complexities and triumphs of modern life.

"ArtMoments Bali aims to support the development of the art market in Indonesia by establishing Bali as one of the art destinations in Southeast Asia. Our mission is to provide a platform to connect the art market with potential buyers in Indonesia and beyond. As well, we would like to offer the chance to acquire art for the public by using Cicilan BCA 0% until 24 months for art items," explained Sendy Widjaja, the Co-Founder and Fair Director of ArtMoments.

ArtMoments Bali opens its doors with a remarkable gong beating moment, signifying the commencement of the event and followed by a stunning performance of traditional Balinese dance. Remarks were also delivered by Christoph Pouls, Resort Manager of InterContinental Bali Resort as the Official Venue Partner, and the honorary guest, the Head of the Bali Provincial Office of Culture, Prof. Dr. I Gede Arya Sugiartha.

"We are honored to be trusted as the official venue partner of ArtMoments Bali 2023. InterContinental Bali Resort has always supported the development of art and culture in Bali. By hosting this exhibition, we hope to contribute to the flourishing art scene and provide a platform for artists to gain recognition and appreciation. "We hope this can bring ideas for the public on displaying art in their living or working spaces so art can become an integral part of their daily life," added Sendy.

The inaugural ArtMoments Bali also presents some exciting programs: CONVERSE MOMENTS, MAKER MOMENTS, and ENCOUNTER MOMENTS involving creative professionals, industry experts and key opinion leaders.

1. **Guide To Making Natural Dyes** (hosted by I Gede Agustinus Darmawan)

Participants will learn about natural flora historically used to color cotton and other fabrics. Artist I Gede Agustinus Darmawan will share the creative process in his collaborative work with a Balinese weaving community, in which colors are used to color cotton for woven ikat cloths. The workshop will involve a hands-on session where participants can design and embellish their cotton tote bag using natural dyes made from flowers, plants, and other homegrown products.
